Colchester Street Name Plates August 2018.

E.J.Russell stated that these original cast iron street names were put up under the Town Clauses Improvement Act of 1847.

He listed 15 that remained in 1983. They are in a particular simple style and can be hard to locate

due to the placing of them at first floor height which the eye does not naturally find . They are also not always in the most obvious position in the streetscape either .

From his listing I cannot find those that were in

St Peters Street (this was on the barge boarded wall of the house near Ryegate)

Albert Street

Gray's Cottages, East Street.
